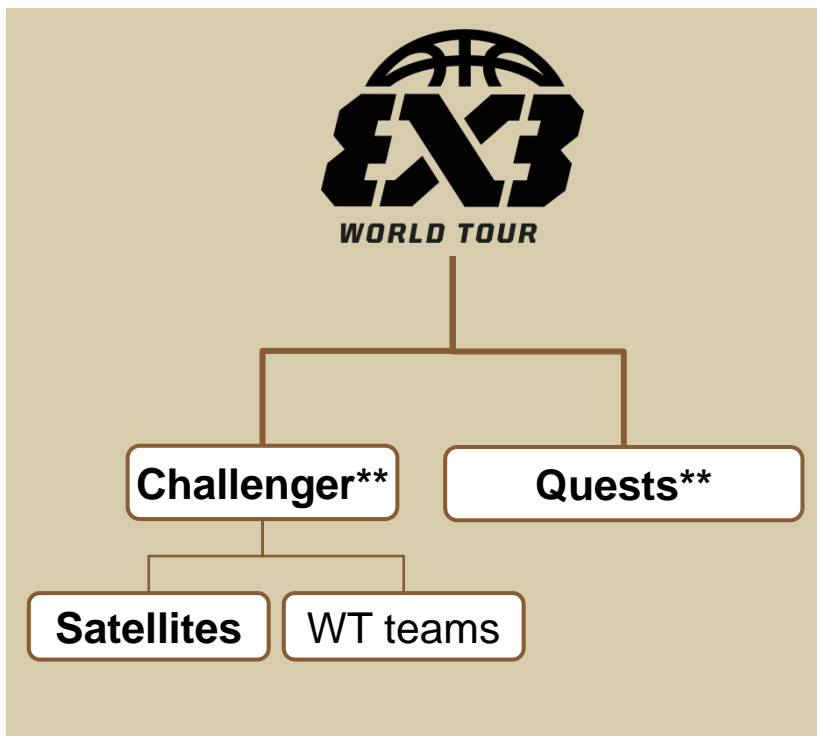

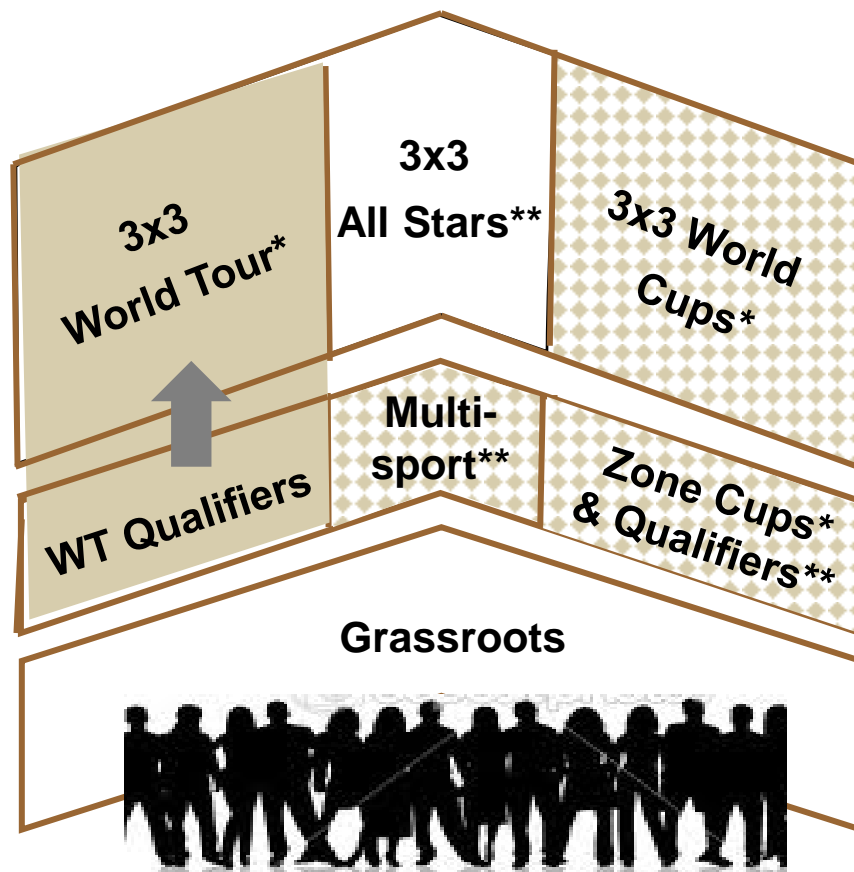


Reminder of FIBA 3x3 Competition Network

premium, dedicated
referees**



Specialisation requires dedicated Programmes

FIBA 3x3 Referee Course

- 2-3 day course with class room sessions & coaching during game officiating
- FIBA invites NFs to nominate candidates or FIBA invites candidates directly
- 8-12 candidates per clinic (2-3 spots reserved for host)
- Written English and Rules Test, evaluation of game officiating
- Candidates have the opportunity – based on results – to obtain FIBA 3x3 Referee License
- Host to provide full-board accommodation, local transportation, meeting room & tournament with catering for all candidates & 1 FIBA 3x3 lecturer
- Host to receive a FIBA contribution of 200 USD (EUR in Europe) per candidate

FIBA 3x3 Officiating Clinic

- 1-2 day clinic for national 3x3 referees with class room sessions & coaching during game
- Host can invite unlimited number of participants
- No tests, no evaluation, no licensing
- Each participant to receive a Certificate of Participation
- Host to cover one-time fee of 500 USD (EUR in Europe) payable to FIBA 3x3 lecturer
- Host to provide international travels, full-board accommodation, local transportation, meeting room and tournament for 1 FIBA 3x3 lecturer

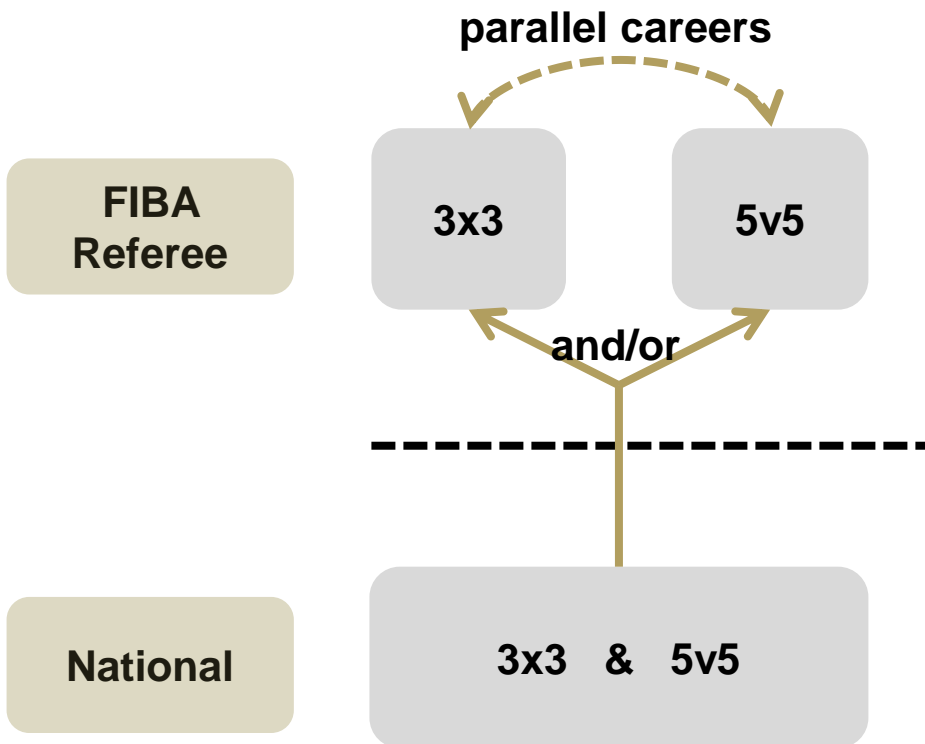

FIBA 3x3 Referee specialisation



- Anybody can be FIBA 3x3 Referee
 - 5v5 license neither requirement nor criterion for exclusion
 - 2 parallel careers – 5v5 and 3x3
 - No age limit to keep license
 - Validity of license tied to minimum number of nominations (automatic downgrade)
- 3x3 path via FIBA 3x3 Referee Courses
 - NF nomination or FIBA 3x3 invitation
 - Classroom sessions, officiating & written exams (English & rules)



Requirements for joining a FIBA 3x3 Referee Course

Candidates:

- Ample experience in FIBA-endorsed 3x3 events & good command of the English language
- Minimum 21 years, maximum 40 years of age (at start of Course)
- Nomination by National Federation or direct invitation by FIBA 3x3

National Federation:

Any NF is entitled to nominate candidates, though, NFs that have held

- minimum 5 events with a total of 100 teams in NF's territory in the previous calendar year or
- a 3x3 Officiating Clinic in cooperation with FIBA 3x3 prior to the FIBA 3x3 Referee Course will get preferential access.

Note: FIBA 3x3 will invite NFs to nominate candidates based on availability of slots at Courses.

Conditions:

- NF/candidate to pay fee of 500 USD (EUR in Europe) via bank transfer upfront to FIBA
- NF/candidate to cover travels and visa cost to closest airport (defined by FIBA) for FIBA 3x3 Referee Course
- At FIBA 3x3 Referee Course complimentary full-board accommodation and local transportation is provided.



Three levels of FIBA 3x3 License

FIBA 3x3 Senior Referee

- Top-level FIBA 3x3 Referee
- Preferred nominations for Official/Recognized Competitions
- Officiating crew leader with strong leadership skills
- Preferential lecturer at FIBA 3x3 Referee Programmes

FIBA 3x3 International Referee

- Very experienced in 3x3
- Nominations for every level
- Potential lecturer at FIBA 3x3 Referee Programmes

FIBA 3x3 Licensed Referee

- Experienced in 3x3
- Entry level in FIBA 3x3 Referee Programme
- Occasional nominations for Recognized Competitions and Official Competitions

License-holders of all 3 levels are part of FIBA`s 3x3 Referee Pool accessible to all promoters here: fiba3x3.com/refs

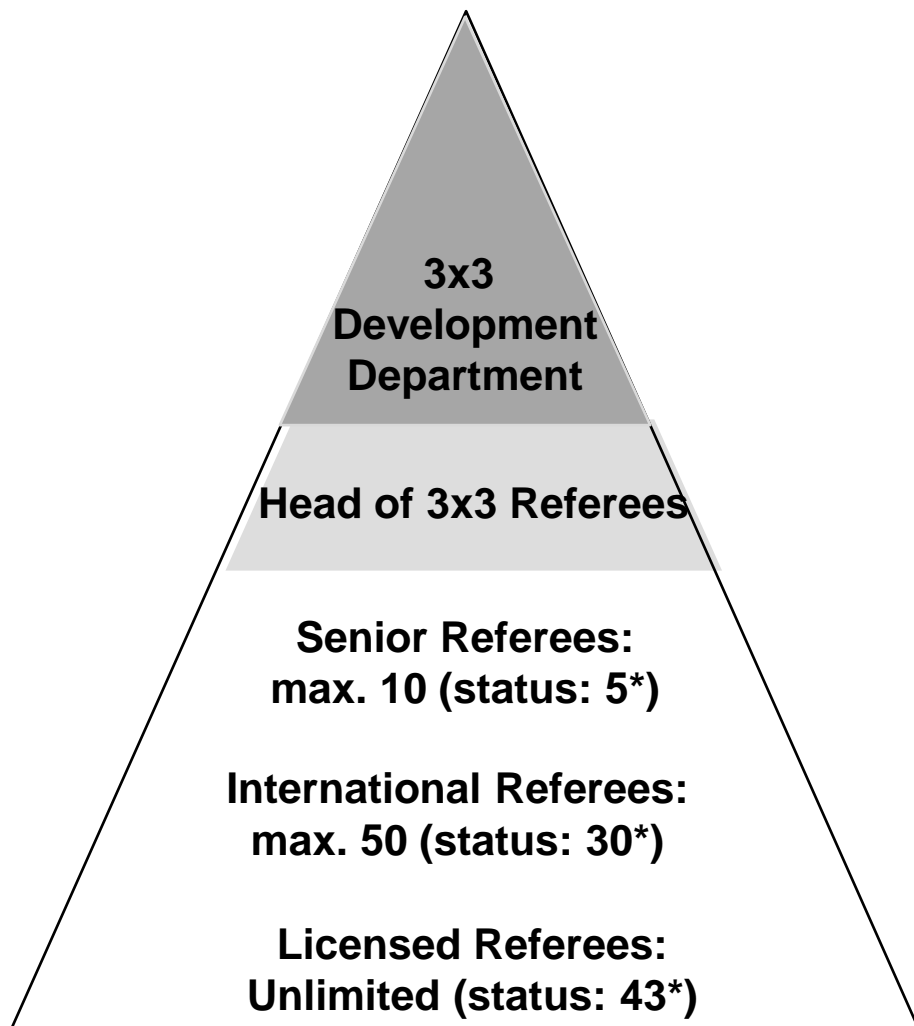

FIBA 3x3 referee slots

- 2017: ca. 200-230 nomination slots required in Official and Recognized Competitions
- Geo restrictions on straight maths
- Numbers to be grown according to needs and competition structure in specific region

- Travels to home airport and visa costs covered by FIBA (except multi-sport events)
- FIBA provides uniform (shirts & shorts) + shoes at all events except Quest Finals & FISU
