



FIBA 3x3 Rankings Quick Guide

Edition 2024





I. CONVENTIONS

There are three official FIBA 3x3 rankings: 1. Individual Ranking, 2. Team Ranking and 3. Federation Ranking. The team and federation ranking are based on the individual ranking.

II. INDIVIDUAL RANKING

1. Overview

The FIBA 3x3 Individual World Ranking of each player is calculated based on points collected considering only the results of the best 9 FIBA3x3-endorsed events played over the last 12 months The number of points earned at a competition will depend on its level (see below section 1 & 2) and players' performance (see section 3):

- a. Final Standings;
- b. Win Before Limit;
- c. Individual Performance: each players' scoring and key individual stats.

2. Calculation:

Rankings will be calculated daily at 1200 hours UTC

3. **Event level** (Definition of each event can be found in Glossary on fiba3x3.com)

Considerations to Event Level:

- In case of a tour (other than Super Leagues), only the event actually qualifying from a
 Quest or Lite Quest to respectively a World Tour Masters or Challenger is considered
 Quest or Lite Quest for ranking purposes, all other events of the tour are considered "all
 other open"; same applies to WS qualifiers;
- FIBA-approved events classifying to a Women's Series Stop are Endorsed and considered Blue;
- Women in men's Endorsed are applied color level ignoring Pro Qualifier status, if any;
- 3x3 events in multi-sport games are treated like Endorsed events; OG (and YOG) is considered as if a Cup (U18);
- Events, other than FIBA 3x3 Official Events, with less than 4 teams will <u>not</u> be considered an event for eligibility purposes;
- If a player participates in more than 3 events within a month, then only the 3 events with the best results are considered for ranking purposes, without considering FIBA 3x3 Official Competitions and Pro Event's qualifiers thereto;
- Endorsed lasting over 7 days and wheelchair will be considered White.

4. Event colors downgrades

<u>Player performance (in Main Draw) downgrades - only for Pro Events:</u>

- Players with a PVALpg of 2 and lower: 1 downgrade,
- Players with PVALpg of 1 and lower: 2 downgrades.

Considerations to up & downgrades:

- The **FIBA 3x3 age categories** are 40+, open, U23, U18, U15 and U13; whereas U23 is treated like open for ranking points purposes except if indicated otherwise.
- Color level applicable to age for U-nn and 40+ is individual driven in all Endorsed, i.e., a U15 playing in U18 gets points for U15 irrespectively of playing in a U18 category. In Endorsed Events: a category with more than 50% players in a U-nn or 40+ age group is downgraded to the color of said age category.
- U15 playing in black, red, pink, brown, purple and blue-coded events will always get 0 points irrespectively of result.
- Gender-derived color is individual driven, i.e., a female gets female points.

5. Individual ranking points collected at events

There is only one table of **individual ranking points** for all FIBA 3x3 Events. Points will depend on the level of the event (crescendo from white to black):

6. Tour points for tour standings

Irrespectively of tournament size, tour points are awarded in each tour's tournament for tour standing purposes:

7. Sanctions

Sanctions to players by FIBA can include the partial or complete loss of ranking points.





III. Team Ranking (pro)

8. Men's Team Ranking

Teams (men) are identified based on **Validated Team concept** of pre-registration to Pro Events.

The (men) **Team Ranking** is the higher of (i) sum of the ranking points of the three highest ranked players in the Extended Roster, or (ii) sum of Collective Points of the best 7 Pro Events over the last 12 months (precedent season's Pro Events only considered for On-going Teams).

Team rankings are used during the season for preferential allocation to Pro Events.

A confirmed player of a top-25 team in the Team Ranking at the end of prior season will lose half (rounded down) his individual points until the end of prior season, only for Team Ranking purposes, in case such player is confirmed to a current season's Validated Team, which

- 1. does not have in its Extended Roster at least 4 who all belonged to the Extended Roster of a same top-20 team in the Team Ranking at the end of prior season; or
- 2. does not have in its Extended Roster at least 5 players of the same nationality.

For the purpose of this clause, a season is assumed to end after the World Tour Final.

9. Women's Team Ranking

Teams (women) are identified based on those registered to the current WS season.

The (women) Team Ranking is the sum of the ranking points of the three highest ranked players in the Extended Roster.

IV. Federation Ranking

10. Overview of Federation Ranking

The **FIBA 3x3 Federation Ranking** is calculated based on ranking points of each national federation. Federation ranking points are the sum of the ranking points of their top **25 nationals** with a confirmed play.fiba3x3.com account (also known as FIBA 3x3 profile) in the respective category; U13 players are excluded from the calculation. In case of tie in federation ranking points, the tied federations will be forced ranked based on each federation's highest ranked player in the corresponding category. Reminder: players tied in points are force ranked using the randomly assigned FIBA 3x3 profile ID.

The combined federation ranking is the geometric mean of the ranking points of men and women.
